Faculty Supervisor Identification Phase (Phase I Deadline: March 22, 2024)

Below is the procedure for identifying Faculty who are interested in supervising an undergraduate student as part of the NUTRA program:

1. Faculty interested in having an **undergraduate student** participate in a patient-oriented research project will need to submit this Supervisor Identification Form. Please note: you do not need to have an undergraduate student identified in advance as there will be an opportunity for interested students to reach out to you to develop an application in Phase II. If you do already have a student in mind, there will be an opportunity for you to identify that student in this phase.
2. This is a *preliminary* phase to identify supervisors and allocate funds for this program. Due to a possible funding constraint, we will be accepting applications from all faculty members seeking students, but preference will be given to full-time faculty if funds will not cover all research projects.
3. Please note that only faculty members conducting patient-oriented research will be considered for the program.
4. This program is open to any post-secondary student resident in Newfoundland and Labrador enrolled at Memorial University but not enrolled in a graduate program. Students will be permitted to submit one application with one faculty member.
5. Students and supervisors will work together to prepare a NUTRA application form in Phase II.

This information will be made available to undergraduate students who are seeking a summer patient-oriented research opportunity. Faculty members must complete this form to be eligible to participate in the NUTRA program.
